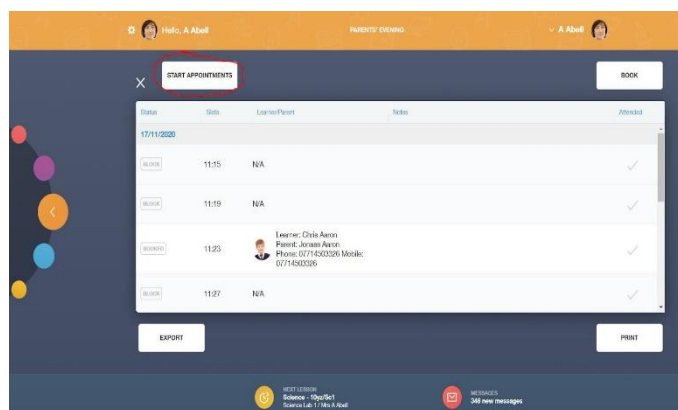


Appointments for the evening can be made through the EduLink App. **Appointments will be available for booking from 8.00am on 13 May Thursday.** Once you are logged on to EduLink via your mobile phone or laptop/computer, you will notice the 'Parents' Evening' icon which you can click on to see which time slots are available for your child's teachers. On some devices this may appear under the 'More' section. As there are limited slots, it may be possible for you to only speak to one teacher for certain subjects where there is more than one teacher taking that subject.

Once you have set up the event and the booking has been made, you will see a start appointments button when clicking on the event. When clicking on this button the meeting screen will appear. The remote video box will remain blank until it's time to connect, but you will be able to see your picture in the local video box. You can turn your video and sound on and off if needed with the controls.

Appointments are 4 minutes long and will start and end automatically. I understand that there is a countdown as the time slot nears the end, but please don't think that you are being 'cut off' by the teacher if the time runs out. If you don't get to the end of your conversation, please feel free to email teachers if you have further questions.
