Dear Parent/ Carer

It was so great to see 160 students join the Curriculum pathway assembly on Monday, despite the current restrictions. If you were unable to view the assembly live or would like to watch again a recording has been uploaded to the students Year 8 Teams page.

The Headteachers' presentation and the subject presentations, that give further information for all lessons, will go live on our website from Thursday 28th January. The Key Stage 4 curriculum pathway, mentioned in the Headteachers presentation, is a new model following the Department for Education guidance and has been designed to offer the broadest curriculum choice as possible.

The school has had a few requests for some students to follow an Attainment 8 route. There is no longer an Attainment 8 route offered due the national changes in curriculum guidance. Our main route follows the new Government guidance that by 2022 75% of young people should study at least one humanity and a language subject as part of their core studies.

There is an alternative pathway for a small cohort of students who may need alternative provision and extra academic support, these students make up less than 25% of the year group in line with government guidance and have been contacted separately.

Finally if your child is bilingual in any language, please contact the school and we can discuss the possibilities of taking this additional language at GCSE if available.
